Now, is there something more you think you should tell us about your parents or grandparents on the Bucklin side?

Facts that you know about and stories of what they did can be added. Did your grandparents live in various places, do things you would want your children to know about? Tell us and get it recorded in our data base for future generations.

You can see it takes our data entry secretary and family history researchers lots of time to simply type information into the data base (and then check it again for accuracy of input). You may want to stop here because you are tired of writing things down. But if you do not do it, who will tell us?

Do you want it remembered when you die? Tell us, or it will not be recorded in the database for future generations to read?

Can you take the time to tell us the names of your brothers and sisters? When and where were they born?

Form 4: More About Other Ancestors That I Know About.

Tell us more about any other (**other than your parents and grandparents that you have told us about on the previous sheets**) of your Bucklin line ancestors born before 1950. Please list ALL the documentary sources you can for facts about the person. Historians take the approach that if no source is listed for an event, the event never happened!

If you want, you can simply fill in the next page (a bibliography page) with the book title or other description of each source, and give that source a number. Then here, where it says "Sources" or "Evidence" you only have to write down the number.
